First published in 1975 *Saothar: Journal of the Irish Labour History Society* is a refereed journal, dedicated to the study of Irish working-class history in its broadest sense, including Irish workers abroad and comparative history. We welcome articles; essays; documents, film and visual art studies; oral histories; archival and conference reports. *Saothar* is currently edited by Dr Peter Rigney and Dr Mary Muldowney.

For *Saothar 48*, to be published in Spring 2023, we are seeking articles which deal with Irish class, labour, and / or gender history. Contributions are particularly welcome from early career scholars. We are interested in contributions which set the Irish experience of 1919 to 1923 in an international perspective and contributions which utilise the Military Service Pensions collection. Submissions can be from earlier periods and those based on digital humanities sources will also be welcome.

Full articles should normally be in the range of 7,000-8,000 words, including footnotes, but shorter articles are welcome. Longer submissions are acceptable but authors must consult the editors in advance. *Cuirfear fáilte roimh aistí i nGaeilge*. Consideration will also be given to conference reports of up to 800 words. Appropriate illustrations will be welcome.

Review articles and reviews are published online, but should adhere to the word limit set by or agreed with the review editor, Dr. Mary McAuliffe.
